



MAGNAT PRESENTS FIRST TURNTABLE IN COMPANY HISTORY

Tested with Audio Technica cartridge:

„[...] Here the Magnat turntable shows its great control and stability in handling music from vinyl. Compared to the much smaller and lighter Thorens, there are sharper contours and more definition in the bass range. The Magnat is neutral in the best sense of the word: neither highs nor lows dominate; all dimensions of the stage are generously represented. Even with “difficult” records, such as Ry Cooder’s ‘Bob Till You Drop’, which is rather brave in the high-frequency range, the Magnat manages to pay just as much attention to the low-frequency and fundamental ranges, so that listening becomes pure pleasure.“
