"The manufacturer's latest sound deck comes in a stylish wooden cabinet with a rippled surface and curved front. This provides space for 4 loudspeakers and a display for easy operation of the sound deck. This is done via the remote control provided, though this is unfortunately rather on the small side. Located on the connection side is an HDMI port, via which the deck is connected to the TV. However, games consoles or players have to access the sound deck via an optical cable or ARC technology via the TV. We would have liked to see at least one more HDMI terminal directly on the deck, though. Bluetooth is provided for wireless music reproduction. As with most home cinema systems, not too much should be expected here in terms of music playback. Despite its compact dimensions, the Sounddeck 150 delivers an energetic performance, which is, however, too noisy for really being able to enjoy music. All that is lacking for films is a bit more bass presence. "
