And how does it sound?:

"Well, actually as expected, if you know Magnat and especially the Transpuls models. The bass is pronounced without pushing itself uncomfortably into the foreground. Rather, the sound reproduction is balanced and but still characterized uninhibited playfulness. The low-frequency fundament is intentionally slightly round, room-filling but not soft, impulses "pop" very convincingly and are physically noticeable regardless of the membrane surface. So you should not be fooled by the not oversized driver, it is powerfully designed."
